
The health workforce can be defined as “all people engaged in actions whose primary intent is to enhance health” ¹.

HEALTH PERSONNEL DISTRIBUTION







HEALTH PERSONNEL DISTRIBUTION BY LOCALITY


TOTAL NUMBER OF ALLIED HEALTH PROFESSIONALS BY LOCALITY




TOTAL NUMBER OF MEDICAL & DENTAL PROFESSIONALS BY LOCALITY

TOTAL NUMBER OF MANAGERIAL, ADMIN & SUPPORT STAFF BY LOCALITY



QUICK FACTS



From 2022 to 2023, expatriate medical specialists increased from **56% (261 specialists)** to **65% (384 specialists)**, while local medical specialists decreased from **44% (206 specialists)** to **35% (208 specialists)**.

Out of the total registered nurse midwives, locals accounted for **40% (148)** in the year 2022. This has increased to **44% (206)** in 2023.



Females have made up **92%** of the nursing workforce nationwide in both 2022 and 2023

In 2022, female general doctors constituted **40% (279)** out of the total general doctors. This increased to **45% (358)** in 2023



In 2022, women held **31% (49)** of health management positions, rising to **42% (57)** in 2023.
